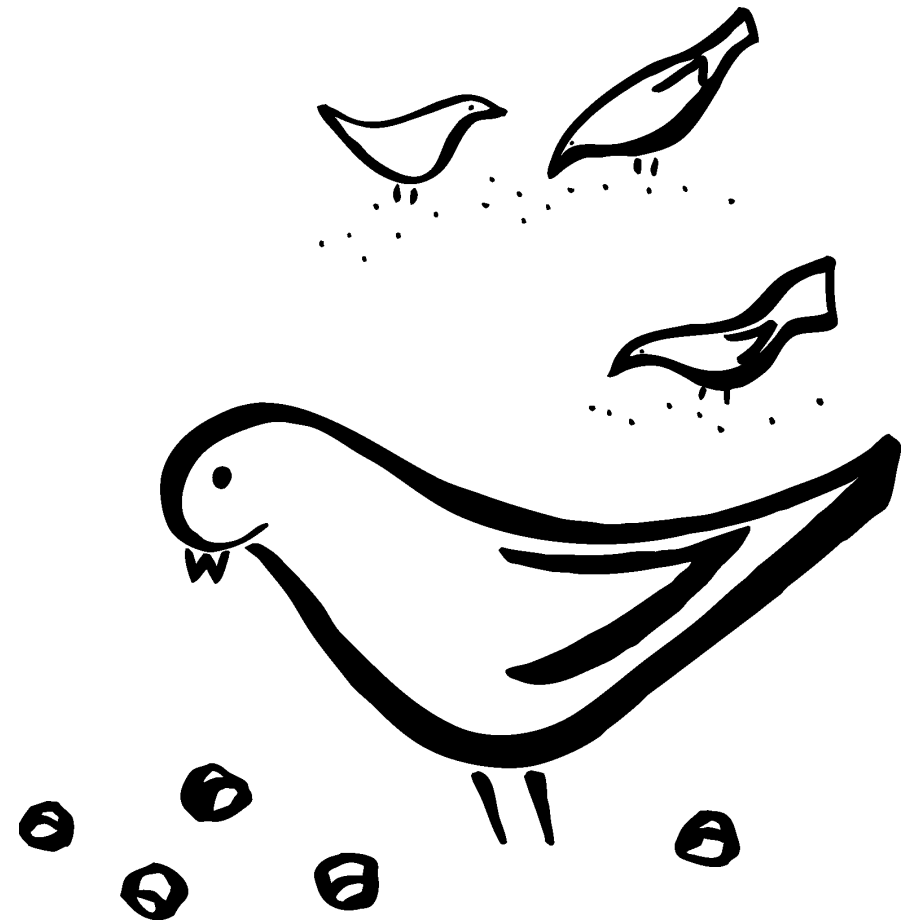

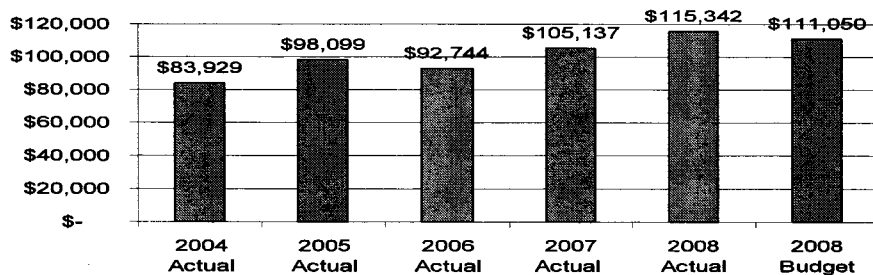

Key Messages

- Giving has been consistent for the quarter, and we are over our budgeted plan needs by \$ 4,292 or 3.8%.
- Net cash position (cash accounts less restricted giving) continues to be negative, however it has improved.
- Expenses were under budget by \$16,204 or 14.0%.
