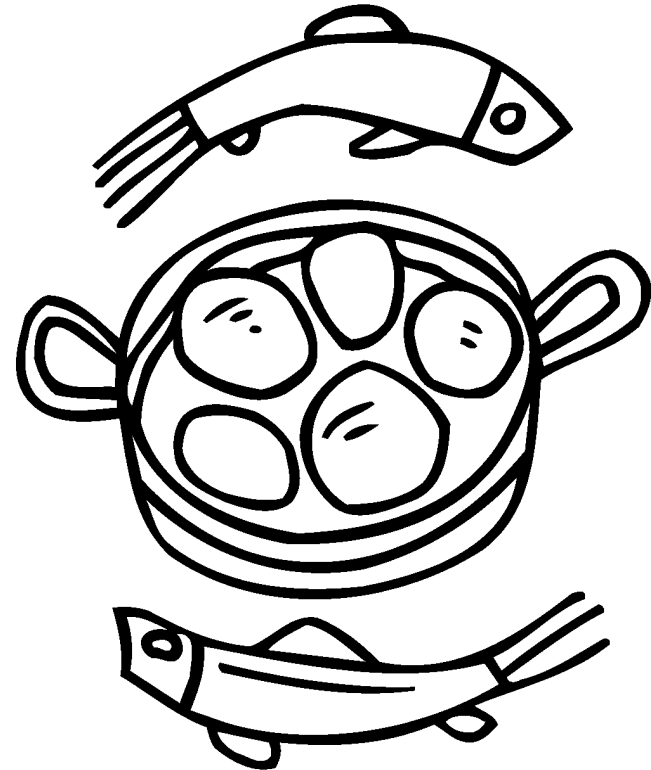

## Your Voices Are Heard

CTK, your concerns about poverty, hunger, and disease, in our global community, were heard. Bobbie Knickerbocker, from Church Women United, joined Effie Hall and Deirdra Schmidt, from CTK, on June 30th, to talk with staff people of Senators Gregg and Sununu and Representative Hodes in their home offices in Nashua. Later, the office of Representative Shea-Porter also was contacted. Your letters supporting the Global Poverty Act asking for better coordination of programs to reduce poverty and to reach the Millennium Development Goals by 2015 had been sent ahead to the Washington offices of our Congressional Representatives.

Our advocacy efforts were strengthened by the artistic expressions of our youth and children which spoke volumes to say "Light up a Life, Don't Dim a Dream." These picture-letters were presented to the Nashua staffers and sent onto the Washington offices. Significant additional funding was recently passed to help fight malaria, HIV/AIDS, and TB throughout the world because our people in Washington heard the voices of voters like you.
