Covenant

The following Youth Encounter rules will apply to both youth and adults at the event:

We will report any illness or personal emergency to our group leader. If we cannot find our group leader or need additional help, we will go to the Event Administrator or the front desk for assistance;

We agree to be in our own rooms and quiet during the listed curfew time.
