## **Meeting Minutes from February 24, 2005**

### **Attendees**

### **Revised Activities Budget**

Dan distributed the original budget turned in the Congregation Council and the revised budget based on the final budget approved at the Congregation meeting. The revised budget is slightly higher than the amount approved, but should be workable. If needed, we will fund some food costs out of the supplies line item.

We discussed the fact that youth and their parents may not be aware of the extent to which this church subsidizes these events. We need to do a better job of this. Dan will begin publishing estimated total costs for future events with the information sent to parents. He will also add language to invite parents who can afford it to reimburse in excess of the stated event cost.

### **Service Project**

#### ***2005 Offsite work week***

This event involves working with kids and the elderly in the Finger Lakes region of New York. It was planned as a major service event for the youth involved in confirmation. This project is now off the table because the parents of the youth who would have been involved did not want their children to participate various reasons.

#### ***Antrim Girls Shelter***

Heidi is working with the Antrim Girls Shelter (run by Lutheran Social Services) to organize a work weekend for the Spring/Summer time frame. This event would involve one or two nights away where the youth would most likely sleep at a local church. The primary activities would be cleanup, minor fix up and some socializing with the residents. The nature of this event will pull the attendees out of their comfort zones and foster teamwork and discipleship.

#### ***CtK Cleanup***

We want to arrange a cleanup day at CtK in May. This will be sponsored by the confirmation youth and will involve all youth in grades seven through twelve. All members of the congregation will be invited to participate. The intent is to involve the

youth heavily in the planning and promotion. This event will be firmed up at the next confirmation huddle.

## **Hampshire Hills Lock In**

Dan provided an update. Everything is moving along according to plan. The budget for this event reflects a \$250 loss (budgeted) if 85 youth attend. This loss disappears to zero at 100 youth. Any profit from the event will be donated to Youth Encounter, over and above the \$500 honorarium.

## **Hammonasset**

Dan provided a brief update. The band this year will be Peter Eide. The speaker has not been named. The event will take place September 9 – 11.

## **Spring Fling**

We are currently conducting sign-ups. Bill and Sophia Carr will be the chaperones. The event takes place from May 20-22.

## **2006 San Antonio Gathering**

This event will take place in July of 2006. Registrations will begin in September. It is likely that we will double up with other ELCA churches. Dan, Pastor Tim and Heidi will oversee the planning for this event.

## **Council Liaison**

When council re-organized, a liaison to Youth Ministry was supposed to have been named. This has not happened. Tami McKay agreed to fill that role until someone else is named.

## **Youth Meetings**

We discussed tentative outing to Boulder Morty's on April 17<sup>th</sup>. Amy Hansen will contact them to determine availability and cost.

## **Youth Roster**

Dan distributed an updated youth roster for review. He will update the roster with the changes identified at the meeting. He also informed the group that he could now easily produce mailing labels for youth.
