Young Adult Initiative

Pastor Keyl provided information on the Young Adult Initiative. This is a project within the New England Synod. It targets adults in the 20 – 34 age range, single or married. Steve Kennedy from the bishop's office is spearheading the project. Kari is working with Steve on this project. There 20000 out of 90000 in this age range in the Nashua area. The assumption is that these people are in a transitional phase in their lives. Ideally there would be a meeting place with possibly a coffee house atmosphere. Pastor Keyl is looking for some in this age range along with a council person to be involved in this project. There is a meeting scheduled for October 3.

Service Project for 2007

We received information regarding a 2007 youth work camp experience from Wayne Twombly from Shepherd of the Valley in Groton, Massachusetts. The event is in Reading, Pennsylvania in June of 2007. It will involve minor house repairs for elderly and poor in the greater Reading area.

Christ the King has been trying to initiate a non-local servant event for a number of years. We decided to reserve 6 slots for this event. The estimated cost is 500 – 600 per person. There will be a significant amount of fundraising needed.

San Antonio

We want share the experience with the congregation with a poster and slide show that we will display between services. Lisa Hansen will make the poster. She will need pictures to include. Judy will work on a slide show. We would like to do this early in November.

Hammonasset

Youth Quake

This event will be held in Worcester, Massachusetts on January 26 – 28, 2007. Dan will place the sign-up forms on the youth bulletin board and on the web site. We need to know who is going by September 30. The cost per youth for this event is \$80, up from \$50. The increase is to help keep costs down while CtK works through its stewardship issues.

Zone

This event is sponsored by Youth Encounter, the same organization that sponsors Youth Quake. The event is open to 10 – 12th graders. It will be held in Southbury, Connecticut February 2-4, 2007. This will be the first Christ the King youth will attend this event. The cost per youth for this event is \$80.

Project Compassion

We have terminated our relationship with Project Compassion. Instead, we will sponsor the tuition for a Liberian student.
